2025-2026 College of Adult & Professional Studies MDE School Social Work Scholarship



The Social Work Department is seeking to award students who are interested in pursuing a career as a school social worker. This opportunity is designed to support the development of professionals dedicated to making a positive impact on students' well-being and academic success in the school setting. Current junior and senior students are encouraged to apply for this scholarship with preference given to new students who will be joining the social work program.

Recipients will be awarded up to \$15,000 for the academic year with the scholarship split evenly between fall and spring semesters. It is important to note that the scholarship is not renewable and does not meet the IRS standards for qualified scholarships, and therefore the funds should be reported as taxable income for tax purposes. Please see below for eligibility criteria for the scholarship.

Recipients must:

- 1. Enroll in the Social Work program with an anticipated graduation for academic years 2026 or 2027 with Social Work as your primary major.
- 2. Complete the scholarship application and must be received by Bethel's Social Work Department by the deadline of May 4th, 2025.
- 3. Be enrolled full time for the academic year (12 credits per term in courses required for student's program of study).
- 4. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25
- 5. Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress.
- 6. Must agree to commit to one year of eligible employment with a Minnesota school following the completion of the social work program.

Eligibility Requirements: Recipients do not need to demonstrate need. Bethel may need to reduce institutionally-controlled aid and/or other outside aid to prevent an overaward.
