OUR CHURCH

The faithful community of Greater Portland Bible Church aspires to be a beacon in our city. Since the formation of the church in 1977, this family of believers has been doing life together in a God-honoring way. A non- denominational, multigenerational church family, robust in age and ethnicity, GPBC's hospitable and welcoming spirit is only rivaled by its generosity and kindness.

The church's mission is Helping People Find and Follow Jesus Together. Our core values are Centering on Jesus and being Bible-Based, Loving and Worshiping God, Loving and Caring for One Another, Growing Spiritually, Serving God and Making Disciples, and Reaching Others.

We are a grace-filled community. We desire to see people from all walks of life find and follow Jesus. Our recently remodeled facility built in 1991 is fully paid for, and includes 42,000 SF of classrooms, offices, and worship center that seats 400. It also has a 4000 square-foot Student Ministry Center and sits on 16 beautiful acres in the west hills of Portland.

Our outreach to the community is multifaceted, operating a weekly food bank for many families in the area, a partnership with Habitat for Humanity with 52 units under construction adjacent to our church property, a homework club for kids who live in apartments and Habitat homes nearby, and ministry on our local high school campus. While prioritizing loving our community, this fellowship doesn't neglect our brothers and sisters around the world. Supporting and encouraging more than a dozen global partners is core to our very identity. Through our involvement with the global church, a heart of appreciation for other cultures has emerged. Our members include many people with various ethnic and cultural backgrounds, including our weekly Spanish worship service. We at GPBC want to reach others and see God glorified, enjoying the peace and joy of Jesus, and reveling in relationships with other believers.

OUR REGION

Portland is also the home to the NBA Trailblazers, the MLS Timbers, and the NWSL Thorns.
