Students planning on graduate school should choose [PSY 230M](#) Introduction to Statistical Methods and Experimental Design or [MAT 207M](#) Statistical Analysis to satisfy the Mathematics (M) course requirement.

[BIO 104](#) /[BIO 104D](#) is a required course for Social Work. It may also meet the general education Laboratory Science requirement.
