Format for Electronic Submission

Candidates for promotion are **required to use the naming convention below** for documents that are submitted for application for promotion. Documents are due on January 15 unless it falls on a weekend, in which case they are due at 9:00 a.m. on the Monday after.

Academic Affairs provides you with a personal Google link for you to upload your materials to.

Submit all documents in PDF format. These document titles match the list of required documents listed on the Promotion Portfolio Requirements.

EXAMPLE: For the examples below, Brian Smith is the candidate for promotion.
